Introduction

In response to feedback, WCMT has been developing the support that we offer to Fellows. As a result, we now have additional resources available to Fellows interested in organising events that support the work of our networks or showcase the remarkable work that Fellows are undertaking.

What we can offer?

The first thing we have available, is a meeting space, adjacent to our office in London. The room holds 10-12 people, and is ideal for initial meet-ups, discussions and small workshops.

We also have a small budget available to support events, either at our space or another location. Our small budget would be able to support, for example, materials needed to run a workshop, travel expenses for a guest speaker, lunch for those attending, the cost of renting a room or space in which to meet.

We are also happy to help market events, both through our social media presence, and to Churchill Fellows' through the networks, as well as providing behind the scenes assistance as necessary.

Is my event eligible?

Events are funded at WCMT's discretion. However, you are likely to be successful if your event fulfils the following criteria:

- Your event is planned on behalf of a Fellows' network, or for the benefit of Churchill Fellows
- Your event involves 3 or more Churchill Fellows
- Your event is not designed for commercial gain or profit*

***If you are intending to fully cover your costs through ticketing we may need to see your business plan for the event**
